WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

Candidates should also have a good understanding of basic mathematical principles, as well as good communication skills to complete lifting operations safely.

Delegates will be assessed in a mix of theoretical and practical elements. Practical exercises will be assessed on an ongoing basis and a theoretical exam is conducted at the end of the course. The key areas of focus include:

- Health and safety legislation
- Duties and responsibilities
- Crane selection and configuration crane set up
- Risk assessments
- Planning and organising lifting operations
- Slinging and signalling
- Lift analysis and sling tensions.
