WHAT ARE THE PREREQUISITES FOR THIS ASSESSMENT?

All learners must hold a valid and in-date OPITO rigger initial training certificate and have a fully completed workplace experience logbook to meet the OPITO rigger requirements.

If a learner does not hold valid certification a formal letter from their employer may be submitted stating that they have met the equivalent of the OPITO rigger logbook requirements.

WHAT ARE THE AIMS OF THIS ASSESSMENT?

To establish that the learner has the required underpinning knowledge, understanding and practical skills to fulfil the role of rigger safely, effectively and competently.



WHAT WILL BE COVERED?


The assessment consists of a mix of ongoing theoretical and practical elements designed to give learners the opportunity to demonstrate their knowledge, understanding and skills in the following areas:

- Effective and safe lifting techniques
- Hazard identification and risk mitigation
- Production of lifting plans
- Effective communication with rigging team
- Lifting equipment – storage and inspections
- Health and safety legislation and associated regulations
- Post-lift procedures.

WHAT CERTIFICATE DO ATTENDEES RECEIVE ON COMPLETION OF THIS ASSESSMENT?

OPITO accredited rigger competence assessment certificate is awarded on successful completion of both the knowledge and practical assessments.

The certification is valid for two years. Before the certificate expires, learners must complete the OPITO competence reassessment to remain certified.
